





#### Fordell School PB4L-SW Purpose Statement

The purpose of PB4L-SW(Positive Behaviour for Learning School Wide) at Fordell School is to further enhance our culture of a safe and positive learning environment where relationships are valued. The Fordell Values are our school-wide expectations for behaviour and learning, and are deliberately modelled, taught and acknowledged.

As you will know this year Fordell School has started the exciting journey of PB4L. We have been Tier 1 this year, which has meant a lot of new learning for all of us. Part of this new learning has included reviewing our school values so that have become portable for all learners and families at Fordell School. Values are the cornerstones for us at Fordell School, they are our expectations, our expected behaviour. We have taken our values and created what this would look like in all settings – this ensures consistency throughout our school. We then teach our students these expectations in each setting, rewarding students when we see them following the expectations.
