Our Spring Writing...

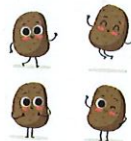


In spring in the garden the flowers are popping up. Beautiful flowers are yellow, red, purple and blue with green stalks. In the garden last night my mum planted snap dragons.
