

SCHOOL DONATION SCHEME 2020

At Fordell school we pride ourselves on delivering the best quality learning opportunities within the NZ curriculum. This asks a lot of our dynamic teachers and staff, and of our parents and whanau by donating time and money towards our rich curriculum. Fordell School is decile 7 and we are at the upper end of the eligible schools for the new Government Donations Scheme.

State schools are legally required to provide free education and enrolment as the current Government funding is intended to cover the full costs, but it has not, and schools have asked for donation and activity fees to help try to cover costs. School donations are voluntary, and parents and whanau can choose to pay in full, in part, or not at all.

The Fordell School Board of Trustees has decided to opt into the new Government Donations scheme for schools in 2020

There are some things that have always been outside the curriculum that will continue to be charged to and paid for by parents and whanau, these include the following:

- Sports team fees and participation in sports teams.
- Uniforms, including sunhats.
- Stationery must be paid for by parents and whanau.
- Technology materials where items are taken home.
- School camp costs for travel, food and accommodation.

At Fordell School transport makes up a large part of the cost to participate in rich curriculum activities and there is no acknowledgement of that in the funding we receive. One bus can cost up to \$350 for one day's activity and will have to come directly from the \$150 per student funds in the donations scheme. This will have a real impact on our rural school, whereas our funding does not reflect the travel costs that we incur.


