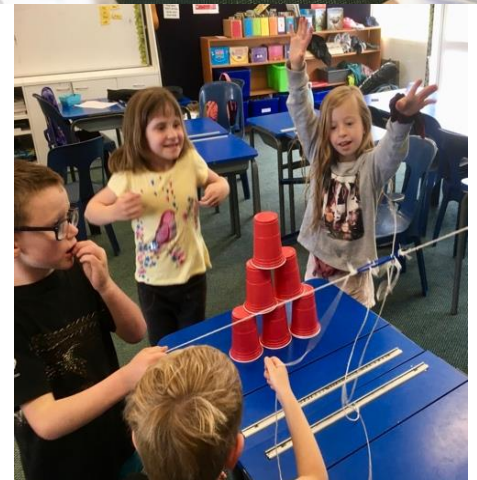
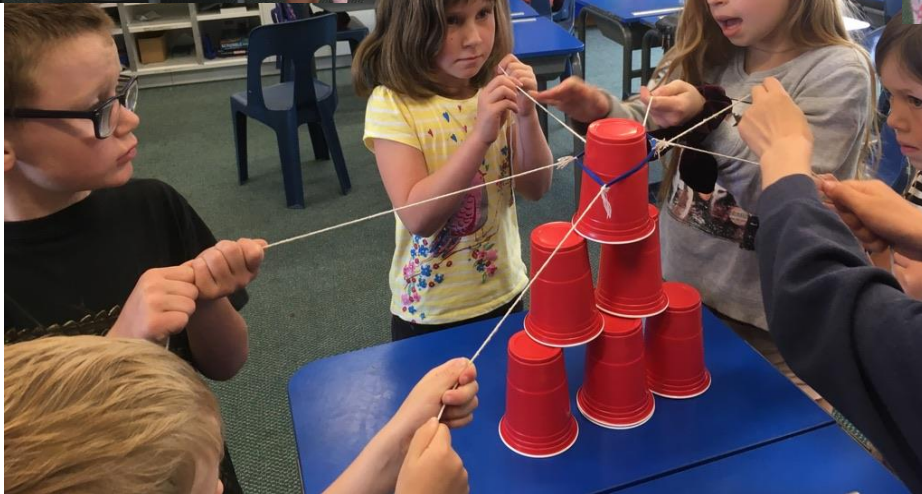
Fordell School Carpark Safety

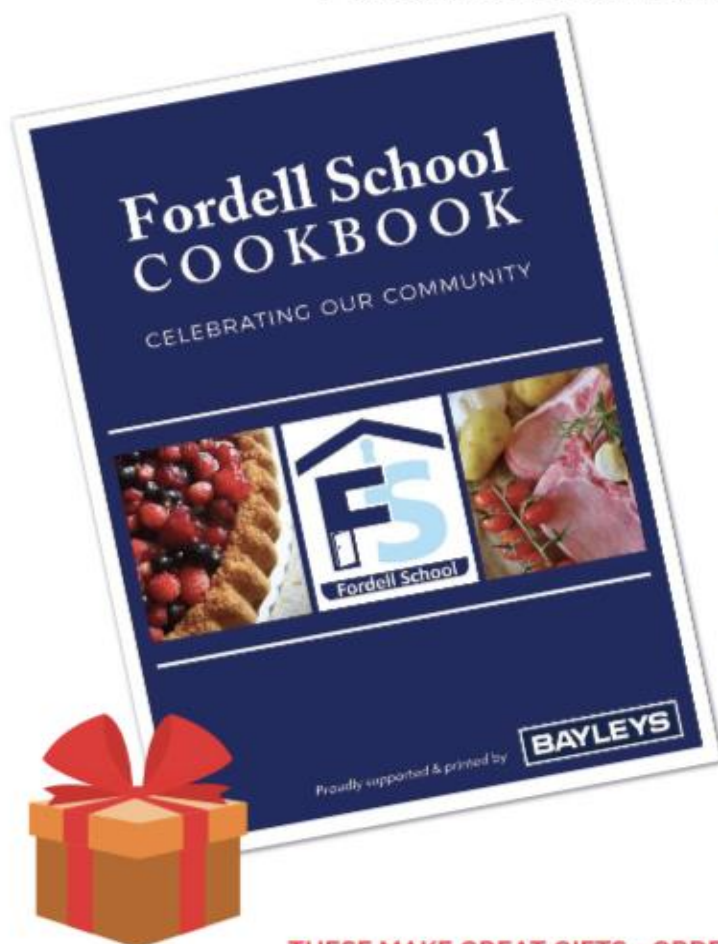
