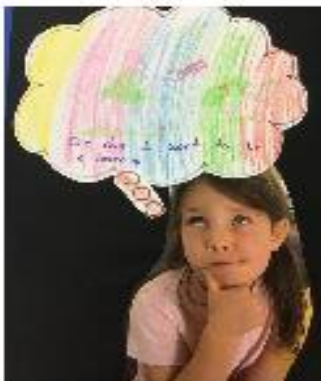
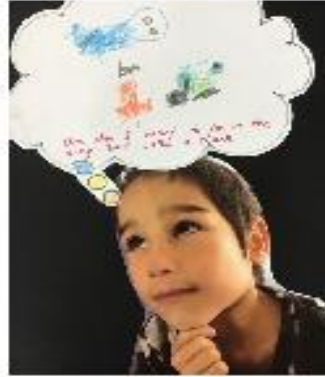

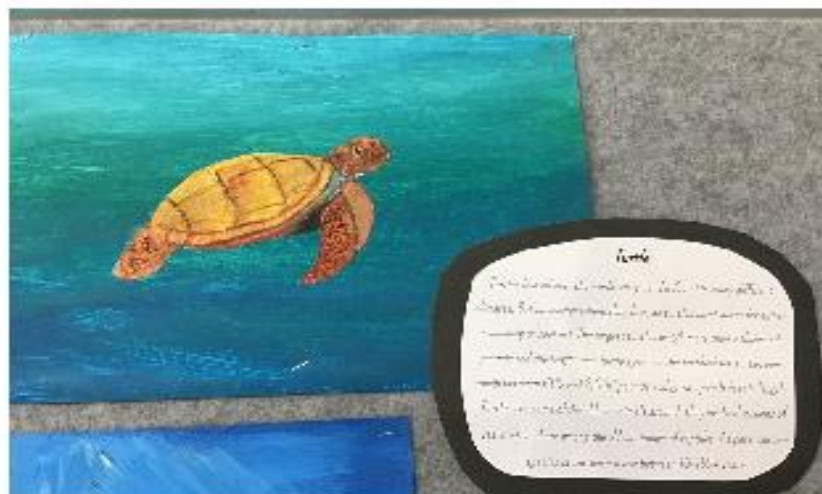
Room 3 have a Growth Mindset!
